

Kitten Proofing Your Home*

Kittens – Boisterous, inquisitive critters that they are – often require kitten-specific safety adjustments in the home. Consider taking the following steps to protect your new kitten ...

- ❖ Store human medications and other chemicals that are toxic to felines in a secure location your kitten can't reach.
- ❖ Place toxic plants in a closed off room or discard them altogether.
- ❖ Stash sewing materials, such as buttons, needles and pins, in a secure spot.
- ❖ Keep windows closed and securely screened.
- ❖ Block off access to open motors and small spaces behind appliances and cabinets.
- ❖ Locate your kitten before you sit down on the sofa or use the recliner.
- ❖ Close the lids and doors to toilets, washing machines, dryers, ovens, etc.
- ❖ Closely supervise your kitten when the stove burners are hot.
- ❖ Tie up window shade and blind pulls so they are out of your kittens reach.
- ❖ Look before you step!
